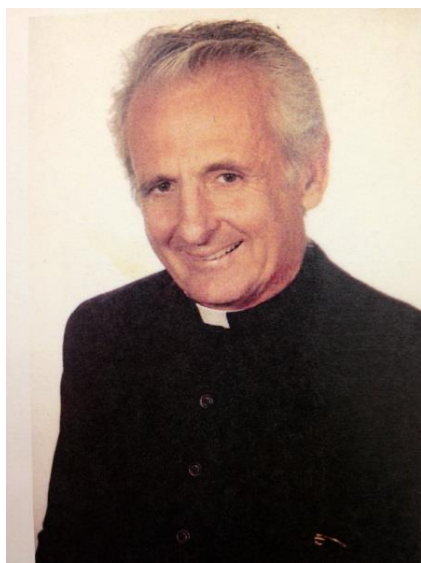


Monsignor Murphy entered into eternal life on Ash Wednesday. He was a native Angeleno born in 1937, graduated from Transfiguration School and ordained from St. John's Seminary at St. Vibiana's Cathedral in 1963. He taught at St. Paul High School (1967-73); was Principal of Bishop Amat High School; and Superintendent of High Schools and Colleges (1977-86). Named a monsignor in 1978, he served as Secretariat Director for the Archdiocese (1986-1991) and Pastor of St. Brendan, Hancock Park (1988-2000).

He was named Administrator of St. Victor, West Hollywood, and then appointed Pastor in 2003 where he served until his death past the usual retirement age for priests and in spite of a very debilitating disease. He was an excellent preacher, wise spiritual director and member of many Boards including the Dan Murphy Foundation, Don Bosco Technical Institute, and Junipero Serra High School. May Christ the High Priest welcome him into the heavenly kingdom!
